Privacy Policy

Overview

The privacy of our members is a top priority. We're committed to safeguarding information you entrust to us. This document describes our privacy policy regarding how we use your personal information.

Scope of policy

This policy applies to RBHA, our members, and users of our website. It does not apply to other organizations' or entities' websites to which we link (such as the City of Rehoboth Beach website). These third-party websites have separate and independent privacy policies. Therefore, RBHA has no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites.

Personal Information

RBHA acknowledges homeowners' right of privacy for personal information defined by us as name, address, telephone numbers or any other unique information that could identify an individual (hereafter referred to as "personal information"). RBHA will not use or disclose personal information except for the purpose of providing information regarding meetings and other matters of interest to homeowners and residents, or as specifically required by government subpoena.

RBHA may use personally identifiable information collected through our website and e-mail accounts to contact members regarding matters concerning homeowners. The email address you provide may be used to send you information and updates pertaining to RBHA, in addition to receiving occasional RBHA news.

RBHA will not sell, distribute, or share any personal information you provide for any reason whatsoever, without your consent. Any personal information we possess will be used for the sole purpose of administering the relationship between you and RBHA.

Online Data Collection Practices

RBHA gathers certain generic data with respect to users of our website, such as the number of unique visitors, the frequency with which they visit, and the areas of the website that they favor. This data is much like television ratings that tell the networks how many people tuned in to a program. We only use this type of data in aggregate. That is, we look at the data on a collective basis, in summary form, rather than on an individual basis. This data helps us determine the extent to which our members and other visitors use certain parts of our website which, in turn, enables us to make it as appealing as possible.

RBHA may also collect personally identifiable information from homeowners or users through online forms, surveys, or other uses where the homeowner or user is invited to volunteer such information.

Member Responsibilities

By becoming an RBHA member, you agree that all information provided to RBHA is true, accurate, complete and current as of the date provided. Members shall correct or amend all incomplete and outdated personal information that RBHA has on file, no later than the next renewal period.
